The scholarship is designed to assist students who wish to continue their education and pursue a career, preferably in the educational field.

Candidate Eligibility Criteria

1. Candidate must intend to continue his/her education.
2. Candidate must be a 2019 graduating high school student who has made application to continue his/her education.
3. The candidate must have a high school diploma.
4. The candidate shall be enrolled/expect to be enrolled as a full-time student in a post-secondary institution of higher education (two or four year college/university, business school, or vocational-technical school institute).
5. The candidate must have a 2.8 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) at the time of application.
6. Candidate shall be responsible for the completion and return of all required support materials, (see application)
