Maintain 2.0 GPA	Eligibility: Begin program within 4 years of receiving H.S. Diploma or GED Waiver is good for 5 years from date of first entry into school	Eligibility: Enrolled in an educational program and working part-time. Must also have funds in savings account and be stable in current placement.
Form: OOH-103 completed by worker & approved by SRA	Form DPP-333 completed by youth & submitted to school's bursar, or financial aid office.	Youth may be required to complete Pre-IL Program first. Other housing options for committed youth may include a foster home or college campus.
