3. Two letters of recommendation (one must be from a person familiar with applicant's academic ability such as a counselor, teacher, etc.) *Letters from relatives will not be accepted.*
4. Essay stating need for the scholarship
5. Verification of acceptance from the college or university to which applicant plans to attend

Since this is a competitive process, please be sure to submit your best work; adhere to deadlines; and clearly express your need for the scholarship. It might also be helpful to have your parent(s), one of your teachers, a mentor, or a qualified peer proofread your essay before it is submitted. *The essay must accompany the application packet.*
