The rules are as follows, and should be conveyed by you to the students:

- Open to all high school seniors graduating in the 2017 2018 School year.
- An entry form (see attached) must be included with all essays returned. That form, along with the essay must be mailed to the KCA & postmarked by Thursday, November 30, 2017.
- Entries should be typed, double-spaced and not exceed 600 words.

Essays will be judged on content as well as writing ability. Essays that do not address the prompt (see attached) will not be considered for the contest. Entries received will be judged by an impartial committee of industry executives. The winning essay will show critical thinking and problem solving as it pertains to the writing prompt, as well as an understanding of Ready Mixed Concrete. The contest winner along with their parents will be KCA's guest at the annual Convention Awards Banquet, February 23rd, 2018 at The Campbell House in Lexington, Kentucky.

KCA reserves the right to publish the winning entry in whole or part. All entries become the property of KCA. The winning entry will be published in KCA's monthly newsletter and website.
